In this case I have charged Trustees with the total amount of Trust funds, as set forth in the Trustees fourth report. Embracing amount of sales in Trustees first, second, third and fourth Reports, I have then allowed Trustees the Commission allowed them by the deed of Trust, legal Costs of suit, and all expenses incurred by them in the execution of the Trust for which vouchers were produced. I have then allowed Trustees first preferred debt paid by them and then allowed Trustees for amount paid by them to Rebecca Baker wife of Henry Baker as provided by said deed of Trust and then distributed the residue of the trust fund to Daniel G.
