This Mortgage made this sixth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand
Eight Hundred and seventy one, by James Russell and Elizabeth Russell his wife
of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Whereas, the said James Russell is just-
ly indebted unto Thomas Russell of Baltimore City in the State of Maryland, in the full
and just sum of Twelve hundred and eighty one dollars, with interest payable semi-
annually, until said debt is paid for which sum and five years interest thereon, he has
passed to the said Thomas Russell his eleven promissory notes, bearing even date
