 Complaint

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court
 for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity

The Bill of Complaint of Mary Richman and Wm W. Richman & Emily Richman his wife of Frederick County, respectfully shew unto your Honor, that Daniel Richman late of said County died on or about the 10th day of January A D. 1877 after having made and executed his last will and testament which has been duly admitted to probate by the Orphan's Court of Frederick County, and a certified Copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 which with all other Exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken as part of this bill of Complaint as fully as if here recited, in words & figures, that by said last will & testament the said Daniel Richman among other devises & bequests devised and bequeathed as follows "I further give to my wife eight hundred and fifty dollars out of the real estate when sold," that your Complainant Mary Richman was the wife of said Daniel Richman at the time of the execution of said will and is now his widow, that by said will the said Daniel Richman after giving sundry other specific pecuniary bequests as by said Exhibit No. 1 will fully appear, directed as follows, "I further order & ordain that my heirs shall sell my real estate whenever they shall agree, to the best advantage to pay the foregoing bequests" & Item, I order & ordain that in case my estate should not reach the foregoing legacies then an equal deduction shall be made from their respective shares, but in case it should exceed the foregoing bequests then the balance of excess shall be equally divided among all my children share & share alike." - That the said Daniel Richman died leaving the following named persons as his children & heirs at law viz: 1 Sarafine a daughter married to Jos. Fox & residing in Frederick County.
 2 = Wm W. Richman a son one of your Complainants married to Emily Richman.
 3 = David Richman a son whose wife is named Susan Richman and who resides in Penna.
 4 = Cornelia Ann a daughter married to John Fox of Frederick County.
 5 = Hannah Elizabeth, a daughter, married to Wm. Lewis of Washington County
 6 = Martha Ann, a daughter, married to Geo Lewis Fox of Frederick County
 7 = Malinda, a daughter, wife of Franklin Wagoner of
 8 = Emeline, a daughter, married to Wm. Benschroff of the State of Penna.
 9 = Cunderalla, a daughter unmarried & living in Balto. City
 10 = Amanda Ellen, a daughter married to Daniel Manahan of Frederick County.
 11 = Newton L. Richman, a son residing in the State of Penna. and all of said children are adults
 12 = The said Daniel Richman also left the following grandchildren & who are his heirs at law, being the children of his daughter Sarolla married to Jas. Brown of Washington County and who died before said testator, viz. Nehru, Nelson, Astory, David, Lewis, Keller, Charles, Emma
