I devise to my daughter Mulinda, married to Frank Wajorman three hundred and forty eight dollars and twenty eight cents.

Item, I devise and bequeath to my daughter Amanda Ellen, married to Daniel Manahan three hundred and sixty five dollars.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Emeline four hundred and twenty dollars. And further I give and bequeath to my daughter Cinderel five hundred dollars. I give and bequeath to my son Reuben five hundred dollars. I further order and ordain that my heirs shall sell my real Estate whenever they shall agree, to the best advantage to pay the foregoing bequests.

Item I direct and ordain that the following named children have already received their equal share, viz. Loulla, William, David, and Hannah Elizabeth. I further order and ordain that the notes I hold against my children that have already received their share of legacy shall be collected. Item, Order and Ordain that in case my Estate should not reach the foregoing legacies, then an equal deduction shall be made from their respective shares, but in case it should exceed the foregoing bequests, then the balance of excess shall be equally divided among all my children share and share alike.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife Mary to be sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.
