Amended Bill of Complaint

That Christian F. Mulyard at the time of his death left surviving him a widow and five children as his only heirs at law, namely Susan J. Mulyard the widow, and John C. Mulyard, Addison Mulyard and John W. Mulyard the Complainants all of which said children are infants under 21 years of age and live in Frederick County State of Maryland and Charles S. Mulyard and Eliza Jane wife of Barber of Montgomery County Ohio the Defendants, all of whom are adults.

Your complainants further shew unto your honors that, the said Christian F. Mulyard at the time of his death was seized and possessed of a house and forty four and one fourth acres of Land which is worth about Twelve hundred dollars situated in Johnsville District, Frederick County State of Maryland.

And your Complainants further shew unto your Honors that it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties and heirs for the said real estate to be sold and the proceeds divided between the widow and the five children, according to their respective shares. The said real estate not being susceptible of advantageous division, which your complainants are, advised, cannot be done without the interference of your Honorable Court. Your Complainants herewith file a certified copy of the deed for the aforesaid real estate, marked Exhibit No. 1, which together with all other Exhibits hereafter to be filed, your Complainants pray may be taken as a part of this their said bill of Complaint.

Your Complainants therefore pray your Honorable Court to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena directed to the aforesaid infant Defendants, commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court and answer the premises, and abide by such decree as may be passed therein by your Honorable Court, and your Complainants will ever pray &c
