To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland in and for the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity.

In this case I have charged the Trustee with the whole amount of Trust funds on hand from estate and allowed him the usual Chancery Commissions, the costs of the suit and the expenses of the sale, together with the amount overpaid by the Trustee on the personal estate which he settled as Administrator, which as appears by voucher No. 2,

I then allowed the widow two fifteenths of the net proceeds of sale of real estate and distributed the residue among the five children of the deceased.
