Decree to Sell
Real Estate

The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer Exhibits depositions and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is therefore, this 29th day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy nine by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the Authority of the said Court, adjudged, ordered and decreed, that the land, and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, free from all claims of dower therein for the purpose of distributing the proceeds of sale among the parties therein in proportion to their respective rights, and that Charles B. Levy and John G. Mottet of Frederick County, be, and are hereby appointed Trustees to make the said sale, and that the course and manner of their proceedings shall be as follows: They shall first file in the Clerk's Office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them with a surety, or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Two thousand Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this Decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order, or decree in the premises. They shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real estate having first given at least three

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
