Know all men by these presents, That we C. Keefer Thomas and John J. Worthington of Frederick County State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Fifteen thousand Dollars, current money, to be paid to the said State or its certain Attorney, to which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind, ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this fifth day of November 1879.

Whereas, a certain Charles E. Worthington of said County being indebted to sundry persons and wishing to secure the payment of said indebtedness, did on the 23rd day of October 1879 execute a deed of Trust to said C. Keefer Thomas of his property for the benefit of his creditors as therein expressed.

Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden C. Keefer Thomas shall well and faithfully perform the trusts reposed in him by said deed of Trust, or that may be, reposed in him by any future Order or Decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting at a Court of Equity, or any other Court of Equity having Jurisdiction in the premises, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
