Testimony of Adam David

Adam Licht, a witness of lawful age, produced upon the part of the Complainant, being duly affirmed and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant, and herewith returned, deposes and says,

- To the 1st Int. - I have known all the parties for some time
- 2d Int. - I was. He is dead. He died in Frederick County Maryland, in October, 1879.
- 3d Int. - He left a widow named Sarah Jane Sharp, and a daughter named Lillie A. Sharp, an infant under the age of twenty one year, who now reside at Middleburg, Carroll County, Md.
- 4th Int. - I am acquainted with the handwriting of George Henry Sharp dec'd. I have frequently seen him sign his name. The signature "George Henry Sharp" attached to "Exhibits No. 1 and A. B" is in the proper handwriting of the said George Henry Sharp.
- 5th Int. - He left personal Estate to the amount of 80\$ or 90\$ and, to my knowledge, he was indebted far beyond that amount.

To the 1st Spl. Int. - He was indebted to me by promissory Note secured by a Mortgage. I look at "Exhibit No 4," now here shown me. And I here produce the Mortgage note.

Complainant here filed Exhibit A. B," which is herewith returned by said Commissioner

2d. Spl. Int. - He did make payments in his life time, to wit.

In addition to this, said Sharp was working for me, and I settled with his wife, who was his Administratrix, and I fell in his debt \$441 which amount was as a credit on the Mortgage debt, by an agreement made between said Sharp and me, during his life time. All the credits above named in this Answer, were credited on the Mortgage under the agreement aforesaid made between said Sharp and this deponent, in the said Sharp's life time.

Whereupon, there being no other witnesses present to be examined and no further being required for the production of Evidence, the Commissioner closed the said Commission and herewith returned the same under his hand and seal on this 5th day of February A. D. 1880.
