Bill of Complaint

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of John A. Hegrange and Phoebe Hegrange his wife, and George W. Hegrange and Eliza Hegrange, his wife, respectfully shew unto your Honor that Elizabeth Hegrange late of Frederick County, died sometime in the year 1869 after having executed her last will and testament a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1 & which with all other Exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint as fully as if here inserted in words and figures, that said Elizabeth Hegrange was at the time of her death seized of an interest in a farm situated in Frederick County containing One hundred and four tenths three eighths acres of Land more or less, also an interest in another tract of Land situated in said County, containing thirty one acres of Land, more or less, and also an interest in a Mountain Lot situated in said County containing Eleven and three eighths acres, more or less; that said farm was composed of several tracts or parcels of Land, described in the recourses herein after recited to said Elizabeth Hegrange and to her first and John Hegrange who survived said Elizabeth but who has also since died, that all of said parcels lie contiguous to one another and make up the said farm and consist of about ninety eight acres which descended to Elizabeth Hegrange and Michael Sumner, ^{as heirs of Michael Sumner} the undivided one half of which was conveyed by said Michael Sumner to said John Hegrange by deed a copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 2, the said Elizabeth and John Hegrange having been seized and possessed of said ninety eight acre parcel as tenants in common - Also of a parcel of land containing about three eighths of an acre described in a deed from Mrs. Attick and wife to said John Hegrange a copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 3 - Also of a parcel of Land containing about One acre described in a deed from
