Jno A. Negrange & Geo. W. Negrange Executors of said Elizabeth Negrange to said John Negrange, a certified copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No 4. - Also of a parcel of Land containing nine & one half acres more or less, described in a deed from John Rimmer to said John Negrange, a certified copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No 5. - And also the two parcels of Land containing 3 Acres, 2 Rods and 27 Perches, and 4 Acres 3 Rods and 38 Perches more or less, respectively conveyed to said John Negrange for life and after his death then to said Elizabeth Negrange in fee simple, described in a deed from David Rimmer a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 6.

That said tract of about One acre of Land was conveyed to said John Negrange for life, and after his death then to said Elizabeth Negrange and is described in said deed from David Rimmer a copy of which is filed herewith and above referred to as Exhibit No 6. - And said Mountain Lot was conveyed to said John Negrange and Elizabeth Negrange as tenants in common by deed from Saul Patten and wife, a certified copy of which is herewith filed as Exhibit No. 7. - And is described as Lot No. 4, in the survey and Plat of Mountain Land made by A. Deane & Co and herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 8. - That Elizabeth Negrange died leaving the following as her only children and heirs at Law, viz:

- 1 John A. Negrange, a son, who is married and whose wife is named Phoebe Negrange.
- 2 George Washington Negrange, a son, who is married and whose wife is named Ella Negrange.
- 3 David J. Negrange, a son, who is married and whose wife is named Josephine Negrange.
- 4 Daniel Wesley Fletcher Negrange, a son who is married and whose wife is named Negrange.
- 5 Catharine Bentz, a daughter, who is the wife of Henry Bentz
- 6 Elizabeth Hans, a daughter, who is the wife of Aaron Hans.
- 7 Nathaniel G. Negrange, a son who is married, and whose wife is named Elizabeth Negrange.
- 8 Ann Rebecca Negrange, a daughter who has since died leaving an illegitimate child named Sarah Ann and who is now the wife of Charles R. Fink.

Your Complainant would further charge that although the said last will and testament of said Elizabeth Negrange was admitted to probate by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County and letters Testamentary thereon to your Complainants Jno A. Negrange and Geo. W. Negrange the Executors named therein but your Complainants are advised that said will was not properly or duly executed as required by law to dispose of property acquired by said Elizabeth Negrange prior to the 14th day of February A. D. 1860, as said Elizabeth Negrange was gone deceased at the time of the execution of said will: And your Complainants are advised and do not urge that said Elizabeth Negrange died intestate as to said Real Estate.
