I will and direct, after the payment of the foregoing legacies, that all the rest and residue of my estate shall be sold by my Executor and equally divided between all my children or their heirs with this exception, that Ann Rebecca my daughter is to have five hundred dollars of said residue, she having already been advanced said sum.

The share of my daughters Elizabeth & Jane and Catharine Pe Bantz to be for their sole, separate and exclusive use and benefit and free from all the marital rights of their present or future husbands

I give devise and bequeath to Sarah A. Hlegrange one of my best beds and bedding.

I give, devise and bequeath to Malley Slater now residing with me, one hundred dollars, to be paid her when she shall arrive at lawful age.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my said son John Alexander Hlegrange and George Washington Hlegrange, to be the sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former Wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other as and for my last will and Testament.
