This Indenture made this Thirtieth day of April in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty six, between Samuel Pattergall and Harriet Pattergall his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and John Negrange and Elizabeth Negrange of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Samuel Pattergall and Harriet his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty five dollars and thirty four and a quarter, cents current money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said John Negrange and Elizabeth Negrange the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Samuel Pattergall and Harriet his wife do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained
