Courses & Distances of The Home Farm of the late John Hlegrance and Elizabeth Hlegrance his wife, in Frederick County, Maryland, the same being part of a tract of Land "The Resurvey on Mount Pleasant," and "The Resurvey on part of Mount Pleasant," part of "Heer Spring" part of "Jones Conclusion" part of "Huejinkard," or be it part of any tract whatever

Beginning for the same at a Stone formerly planted in the public road leading by the land out to the Jefferson or Harpers Ferry Road, it being on the outline of the Land now owned by John Attacks and also being a corner of S. Hewton Hargate's Land and running thence with the divisional line between the Land now being described, and the land owned by said Hargate and Hon. Beard, as the same now bears, 1 South 45 1/2° West 134 1/2 feetches to a Stone formerly planted near the public Road, it being a corner of John Remis Land, thence with the holdings between the land now described and the land of said Remis, 2. S 47 1/2° East 66 1/2 feetches, still with the holdings between the land now described and said Remis Land, 3. South 71° East 58 feetches still 11. North 89 1/2° East 44 1/2 feetches to the North side of a Public road, being the end of the 3d line of the deed from John Remis to John Hlegrance, dated May 12, 1838 for 9 1/2 Acres, with said line reversed connecting the same, along said road 5. South 50° East 28 feetches ending in the public road aforesaid leading out to the Jefferson or Harpers Ferry Road, being on the 11th line of the tract aforesaid called "Huejinkard," and with the outline of said tract connecting the same and down
