Bill of Complaint

The Bill of Complaint of James Boyce and Eliza Boyce his wife respectfully shews unto your Honors that sometime during the year Eighteen Hundred and seventy three or thereabouts, one Letha Jones late of Frederick County and State of Maryland died intestate seized and possessed of certain valuable real estate, consisting of a lot of ground with the improvements thereon situate in said County and State and described in a deed given Jos. Ward and wife to said Letha dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of August in the year 1872 and recorded among the land records of said County in Liber G. M. No. 9, folio 65 as will appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed herewith filed as part hereof and marked Exhibit A, which together with all other Exhibits herewith filed your Complainants pray may be taken and considered as part of this their bill of Complaint as fully as if the same were here in words and figured at length inserted - leaving as her only heirs at law three children, one son Zachariah Jones and two daughters viz Rebecca and your Oratix Eliza.

And your complainants further represent unto your Honors that since the death of said Letha the said Rebecca has married a certain Henry Bryan and that said Zachariah Jones by deed dated on or about the 10th day of October 1871 and recorded in Liber T. G. No 2, folio 186 one of the Land Records for Frederick County aforesaid, conveyed his undivided part or interest in said lot of ground to his sister the said Rebecca Bryan and your Complainant Eliza as will appear by a certified copy of said deed herewith filed as part hereof and marked Exhibit B.
