Henry Bryan have had the entire use and occupancy of said property & that your Complainants have not during said period received any rent or remuneration whatever for the use and occupation of the same or of any part thereof though they have made frequent demand for the same and your Complainants further represent that all of said heirs of said Lethe Jones dec<sup>d</sup> are residents of the State of Maryland and all of them over the age of twenty one years except said Cora Jones who is an infant.

And your Complainants further represent and charge that said real estate is not susceptible of division or partition among the parties entitled without loss and injury to them and that your Complainants are entitled to have the same sold and the proceeds thereof distributed between the parties entitled in proportion to their respective interests and your Complainants further represent and charge that it will be for the benefit and advantage of the parties entitled to have the said real estate sold and the proceeds divided as aforesaid and that they are advised that they are without relief except through the intervention and assistance of your Honorable Court To the end therefore that the said Henry Bryan and Rebecca Bryan his wife, Henry Jones, Augustus Brooks and Martha Brooks his wife, John Jones and Cora Jones may answer the premises and that a decree may be passed by your Honor for the sale of said property by a Trustee to be appointed by your Honorable Court and for the distribution of the proceeds thereof among the parties entitled thereto after deducting all proper costs, charges Commissions &c attending said sale and that your Complainants may be decreed such compensation as may appear just and right for the use and occupation of their undivided part of said property during the period herein before mentioned and that they may have such other and further relief as to your Honor may seem just and right and their case may require.

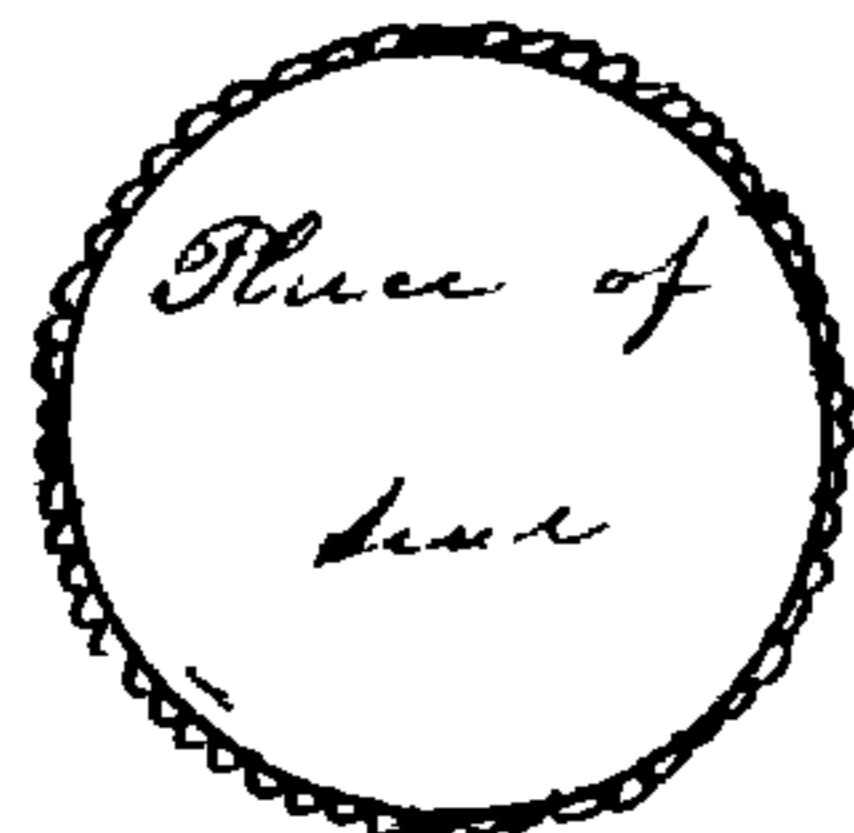
