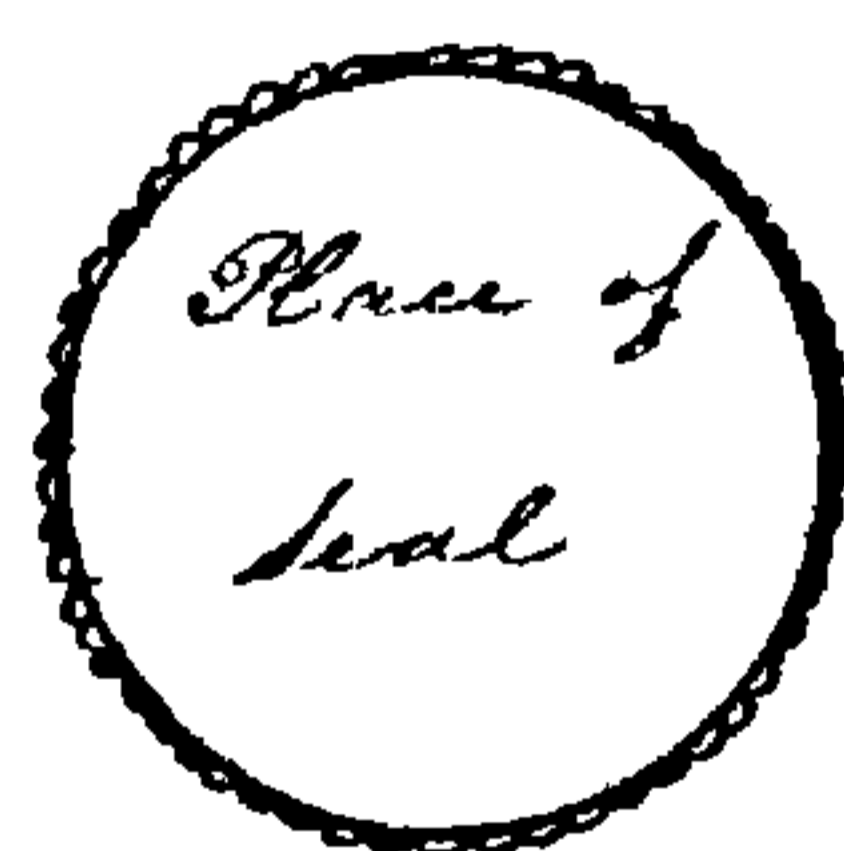
On this 13th day of March in the year of Our Lord 1821, personally appears George Fox Sen^r of Frederick County, party grantor above named before us the subscribers two Justices of the Peace and acknowledges the within instrument of writing to be his act and deed, and the lands and premises therein mentioned and thereby bargained and sold to be the right and estate of George P Fox the within named party grantee his heirs and assigns forever according to the purport true intent and meaning of this instrument of writing and the Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided, and now at the same time also appears Mary the wife of the said George Fox Sen^r and acknowledges the said instrument of writing to be her act and deed, and the lands and premises therein mentioned to be the right and estate of the within mentioned George P Fox, his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mary Fox being by us privately examined apart and out of the hearing of her said husband whether she doth make the acknowledgement of the same willingly and freely and without being induced thereto with fear or threats of or all usage of her said husband or fear of his displeasure acknowledges that she doth make her acknowledgement of the same willingly and freely and without being induced thereto by fear or threats or all usage by her said husband or fear of his displeasure. Witnesseth that the said Jacob Fox and Catharine Fox his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and thirty seven Dollars and fifty cents current money of the United States to them the said Jacob Fox and Catharine his wife, in hand paid by the said George P Fox and George W. Heblanter at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Jacob Fox and Catharine his wife do hereby acknowledge and thereof do release, acquit and discharge the said George P Fox and George W. Heblanter, their heirs, executors, adminis-
