my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named and mentioned, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid.

First. I give and bequeath to my wife Catharine Grove a full and ample support out of the share of two fifths of the rent of my farm in which I now reside, supposed to contain 130 Acres of Land, more or less, & a full free and peaceable home and residence in the house we now occupy on said farm, during her natural life.

Second. I give and bequeath to my Grand-daughter Ann Sophia Grove, one good Milch cow, one feather bed, bedding and bedstead and one chest of drawers to be furnished by my executors, when demanded by said Ann Sophia Grove

Third. It is my will and desire that the farm on which I now reside, supposed to contain 130 Acres more or less, with the Mountain Lot supposed to contain 50 acres be rented during the natural life of my wife to my two sons Henry Grove & Conrad Grove or the survivor - For the rent of the said farm and Mountain Lot they shall pay annually two fifths of all the produce raised thereon, into the hands of the Executors hereinafter mentioned. It is further my will and desire that no wood be cut from the Mountain Lot, unless it be for firewood or repairs of the farm.

Fourthly It is my will and desire that as soon after my death as my Executors shall deem it advisable, they shall sell at public sale all my personal property, and the farm on which my son Jacob Grove now resides. The proceeds of the sale of said farm and personal property to be disposed of as hereinafter mentioned.

Fifthly it is my will and desire that after the expenses of a full and ample support for my wife, and the expenses of repairs and the taxes on the farm are deducted out of the two fifths arising out of the rent of the farm rented to my two sons Henry Grove and Conrad Grove from the balance shall be equally divided among my heirs.

Sixthly It is my will and desire that after the death of my wife the farm on which I now reside, containing 130 Acres of Land more or less shall be sold at public sale, and the proceeds divided as hereinafter directed.

Seventhly It is my will and desire that as soon, as soon, as possible after the sale of my personal property & the farm on which my son Jacob Grove resides, the proceeds arising from said sale, shall be equally divided among my children and paid over to them except the share falling due to my son Jacob Grove, that shall be disposed of as hereafter mentioned.

8th - It is my will and desire that after the death of my wife the farm on which I now reside containing 130 acres more or less shall be sold the proceeds of sale shall be equally divided among my lawful heirs and paid over to them except such portion as shall fall to the share of my son Jacob Grove which shall be disposed of as hereinafter mentioned

9th. It is my will and desire that in the division of the money Bonds, Notes &c. which may be in my possession, at the time of my death, shall be equally divided and paid over to my lawful heirs except the portion falling to son Jacob Grove, that shall be disposed of as hereinafter mentioned.

It is my will and pleasure that the Mountain Lot attached to the farm I now reside on be sold at the same time said farm is sold & the proceeds be equally divided
