Will of John  
Montgomery

I John Montgomery of Frederick County and State of Maryland, being aged and infirm and knowing the uncertainty of life, and to be the better prepared to go when the Lord shall please to call me, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament.

Item 1<sup>st</sup>. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Montgomery all my property, real, personal, or mixed, to her for her use and benefit, so long as she shall live after me.

Item 2<sup>nd</sup>. After the death of my beloved wife, Mary, my will and desires is all my property, real, personal or mixed of whatever kind or wherever found, to be equally divided between my children, share and share alike, with the exception of my daughter Isabella intermarried to Pales C. Rogers, my will and desires is that my daughter Isabella have an equal share with the rest of my children, but I leave her share in the hands of my Executors hereafter to be named, to be paid to her, my will and desire is, that my daughter Isabella Rogers share of my estate be invested by my executors and the interest paid to her the Isabella.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup>. My will and desire is that after the death of my daughter Isabella Rogers, the balance of her share of my estate, be equally divided, with my children, share and share alike.

Item 4<sup>th</sup>. And lastly I leave my beloved sons John W. Montgomery and James S. Montgomery my Executors of this my last Will and Testament, re- voking and annulling all others. As Witness I hereunto affix my name and seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April Eighteen hundred and seven years

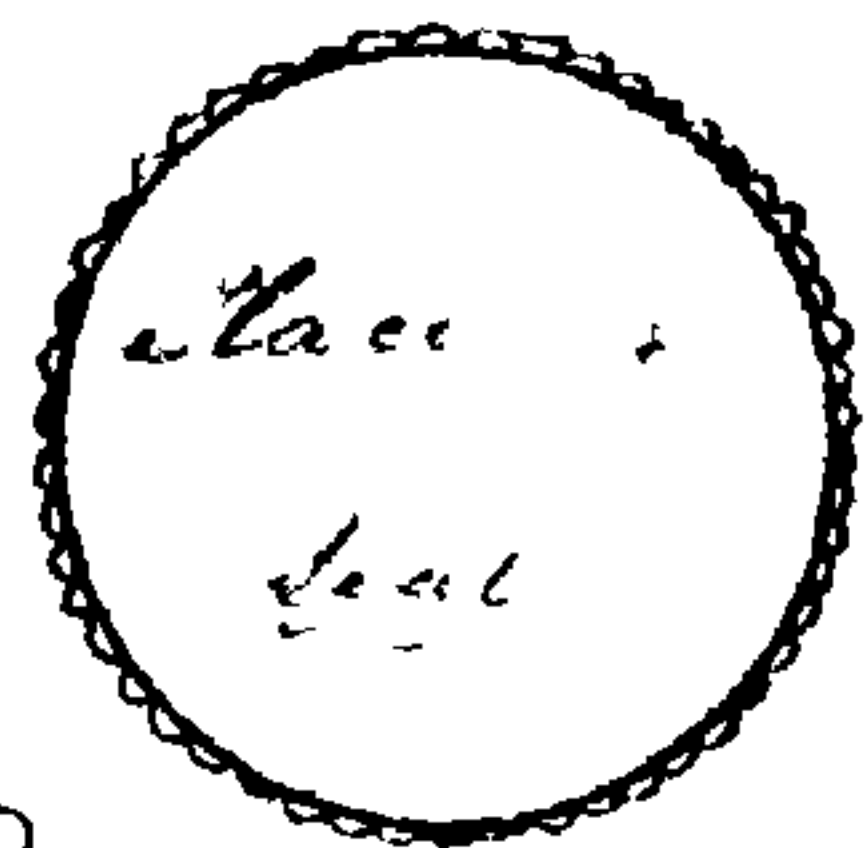
