At the execution of the annexed Commission, issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and to me directed, and empowering me to take evidence in the Cause therein depending, between Margaret E. Marlow & others, as Complainants and Thos. Marlow & others, as Defendants, J. Wells and B. Nelson, one of the Commissioners therein named did, on the 30th day of September 1879, at my Office in Frederick City, Maryland, then and there, proceed to take the following testimony, to wit:

The Complainants filed with the Commissioner as Evidence, Exhibits Nos 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5" which are herewith returned by said Commissioner.

Testimony

- Margaret E. Marlow, a witness of lawful age, produced upon the part of the Complainants, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant, and herewith returned, deposes and says, to the
- 1st Int. My name is Margaret E. Marlow, aged about forty-eight years, and I reside in Frederick County, Md.
- 2d Int. - I have known them all for a number of years. -
- 3d Int. - I was. He is dead. He died about twenty four years ago, in Frederick County, Maryland.
- 4th Int. - He died seized and possessed of Real Estate situated near Selawie in Frederick County, Md. He left about Three hundred acres of land, of which about one hundred acres has been sold since his death. There are about two hundred acres left, worth about fifty dollars per acre.
- 5th Int. - I look at "Exhibits Nos 4 & 5," now here shown me. It is I look at "Exhibits Nos 2 & 3" now here shown me the real estate therein described is that which was sold off since the death of the said Thomas J. Marlow.
- 6th Int. - He left a widow named Mary Marlow, who died in May 1879, in Frederick County, Maryland.
- 7th Int. - He left two sisters, namely, Margaret A. Marlow, and Ann M. Marlow. They are both dead. Margaret A. Marlow has been dead twenty one or twenty two years, and
