The foregoing Petition and Exhibits, filed therewith of Ann Broadwater, having by the Court been read and considered, It is therefore this Fifteenth day of July 1880, by the Circuit Court of Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity ordered that the Auditor of this Court distribute to the Petitioner Ann Broadwater the One eleventh part of the proceeds of Sale of the Real Estate made by the Trustees in said Cause, less Commissions & Expenses of these proceedings, as Assignee of Parmour Marlow, and also distribute to the said Ann Broadwater, as Judgment Creditor of the said Parmour an equal portion with other Judgment Creditors of even date of the said Parmour Marlow, of the share or portion of the said Parmour as one of the heirs at Law of William G.
