The Bill then prays for a sale of the mortgaged premises under a decree of the Court for the purpose of paying the debt due the Complainants, that the defendant William A. Smith and Susan Smith his wife, Mary Ann Smith, Robert Smith, James Smith and Jennie Smith his wife, Lewis Smith, Ida Smith, Laura Smith George Jones, Frank Jones, Ida Jones, Ellen Jones and Eli Jones may be summoned in by subpoena to answer the Bill of Complaint; and that the said Eli Smith the non resident may by order of publication be notified of the object & substance of said Bill and to appear to answer the same and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed in the premises, and for such other relief as may be necessary.

It is therefore adjudged and ordered that the Complainants, by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once each of four successive weeks before the 6th day of March A. D., 1880, give notice to the absent defendant Eli Smith of the object and substance of this Bill and warn him to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before the 12th day of June A. D., 1880 to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed thereon

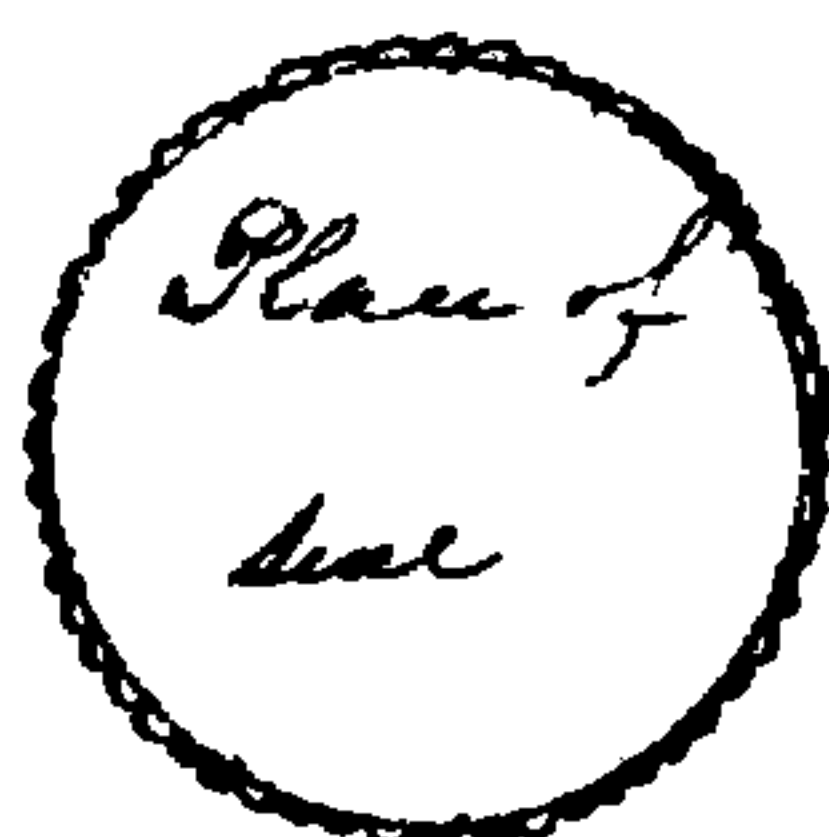
