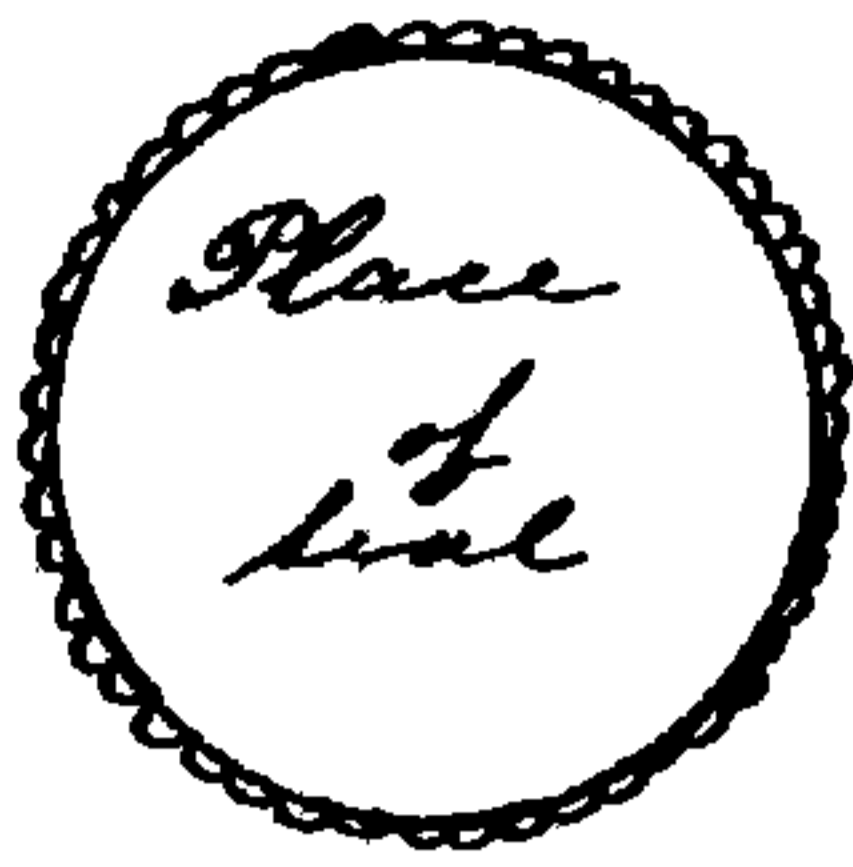

State of Maryland, to Christian Weisner and Charles Weisner of Frederick County, Greeting:

Whereas a certain Nathaniel J. Wilson has exhibited to us in the Circuit Court for Frederick County here sitting in Equity his Petition charging that Christian Weisner and Charles Weisner, one or both of them lay claim to the ownership of certain crops growing or standing on the farm recently sold by Nathaniel J. Wilson and now in the occupancy of Charles Weisner, and which is fully described in the Report of Sales and Exhibits accompanying the same being No. 4499 Equity on the Equity Blocket of said Court

Therefore, we do hereby command and enjoin you the said Christian Weisner and Charles Weisner, and each of you, your agents, attorneys and employees from cutting, selling, disposing of, removing or in any way interfering with the crops which were standing or growing upon said real estate on the 14th day of June 1879 at the time of the sale to the said Nathaniel J. Wilson, situate in Urbana District Frederick County, State of Maryland - Until the further order of this Honorable Court in the premises be made known.
