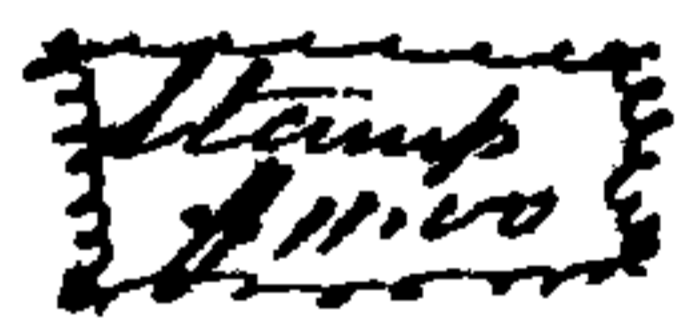

This deed made this 28th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty eight, by Alexander S. Horner and Tomsey P. Horner wife of Alexander S. Horner of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of Ten thousand seven hundred and twenty dollars the said Alexander S.
