At the request of Nicholas Fogle, the following deed is recorded the 1st day of June, 1858.

This Indenture, made this Twentieth day of May, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, between Conrad Alexander and Ann Alexander his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland of the one part and Nicholas Fogle of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said Conrad Alexander and Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty five dollars, current money of the United States to them in hand paid by or satisfactorily secured to be paid by the said Nicholas Fogle on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, they except whereof they, the said Conrad Alexander and Ann Alexander his wife, do hereby acknowledge, and from every part and parcel thereof do hereby acquit, exonerate, and discharge the said the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs, executors, and administrators they the said Conrad Alexander and Ann Alexander his wife have granted, bargained, and sold, aliened, enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, and sell, alien, enfeoff, and confirm unto the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs and assigns forever all the following described parcels of land being part of the Tract called "Sandy Spring" and also part of the Reservey called "Long Bottom Enlarged" Beginning first to include said two parcels of Land as here by bargained, and sold, at the end of the twenty second line of the Reservey aforesaid, and running thence North twenty six degrees East eight & fourteen the perches, thence by dividing lines thence South Eighty three degrees West, fifty two perches, South fifty seven and a half degrees West twenty two perches, and a quarter perches, to a stone, South Eleven degrees East fourteen perches to a stone planted on the twenty second line, aforesaid, and with it to the above mentioned place of Beginning; Containing in all eight acres and a half and eleven square perches of Land. Together with, all and singular the buildings, improvements, rights, liberties, privileges, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Conrad Alexander and Ann Alexander his wife, both at law and in Equity of, in, and to, and out of, the said, described parcels of Land, and premises, and every part and parcel thereof as hereby bargained, and sold, or meant, mentioned, or intended, so to be. To have, and to hold, the said parcels of Land & premises, as aforesaid, described, by, whatever name the same may be called, together with, their, and every of their, appurtenances, thereunto belonging, as aforesaid described unto the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs, and assigns forever, and to and for his or their only use, and behoof, intent, or purpose whatsoever, and they the said Conrad
