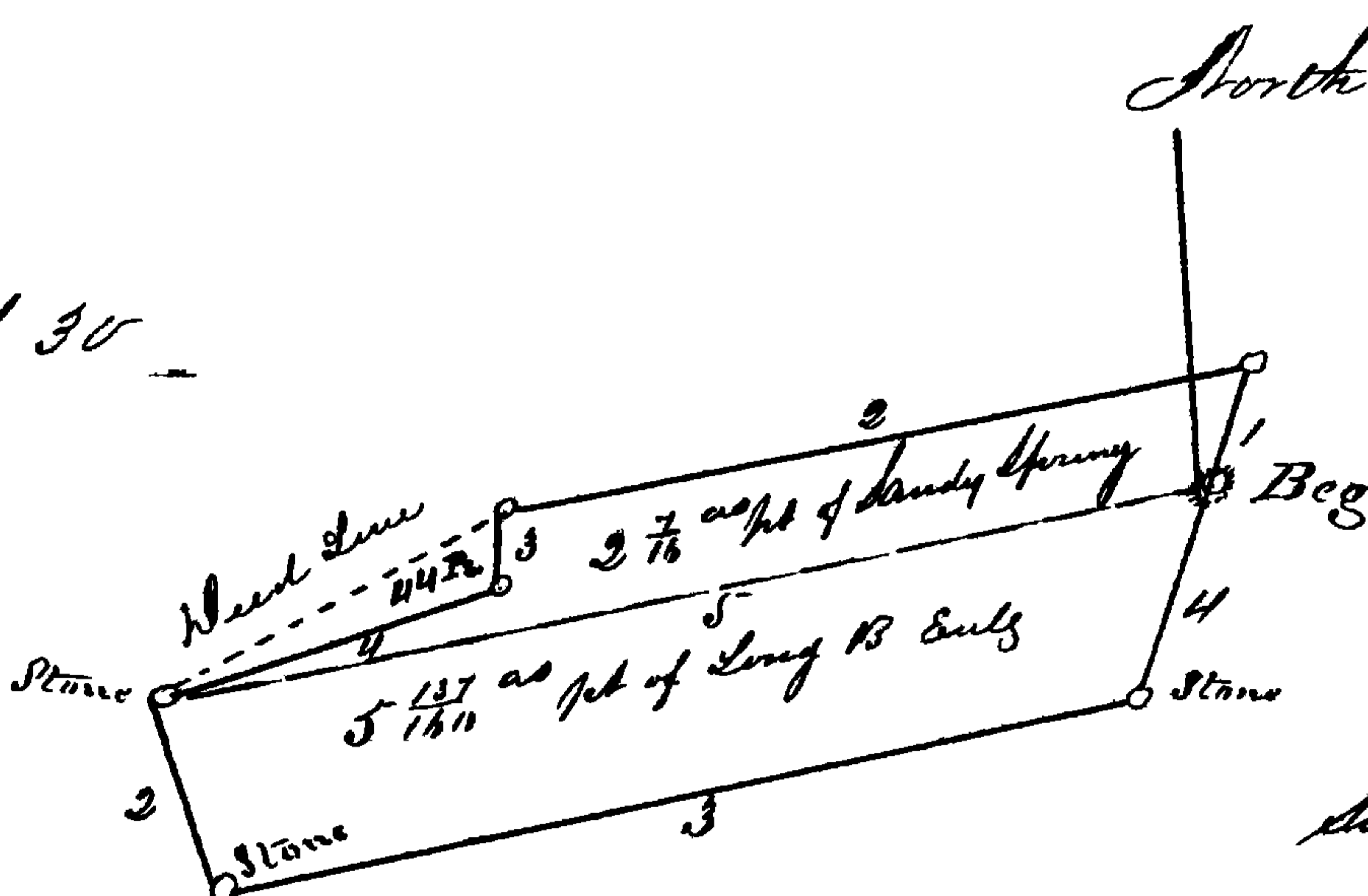

At the request of Nicholas Fogle, the following deed is recorded, 24th November 1843.

This Indenture, made this 26th day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty three, between Conrad Sler and Ann Maria Sler his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part and Nicholas Fogle of the County and State aforesaid, of the other part, Witnesseth that they the said Conrad Sler and Ann Maria Sler, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and forty Dollars, Eighty seven and a half cents current money to them in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Nicholas Fogle, on or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said Conrad Sler and Ann Maria Sler do hereby acknowledge, and from every part & parcel thereof do hereby acquit, generate & discharge
