At the Request of Nicholas Fogle the following Deed, was recorded January 6th, 1845

This Indenture made this sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty four, Between Conrad Sler and Ann Maria Sler his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and Nicholas Fogle of the County & State aforesaid of the other part

Witnesseth, that they the said Conrad Sler and Ann Maria Sler his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty five dollars, and eight cents current money to them in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Nicholas Fogle, on or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Conrad Sler, and Ann Maria Sler his wife, do hereby acknowledge, and from every part and parcel thereof do hereby acquit exonerate, and discharge the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs executors, and Administrators they the said Conrad Sler and Ann Maria Sler his wife, have granted bargained & sold, aliened enfeoffed, and confirmed by these presents, do give grant bargain & sell, alien, enfeoff, and confirm unto the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs & assigns forever, the following, described parcel of Land being part of, or tract or parcel of Land, called "Gandy Spring," and situate in the County and State aforesaid Beginning for the part or parcel of Land
