The said Ann Maria Sler having signed, sealed, and acknowledged said Indenture, out of the presence, and hearing of her husband and the said Ann Maria Sler being by us privately examined, out of the presence and hearing of her said husband whether she does execute, and acknowledge the same freely, and willingly, and without being induced to do so by fear, or threats of or ill usage by her husband or by fear of his displeasure, acknowledges, and says that she does, and we further certify that Conrad Sler, and Ann Maria Sler his wife the persons who acknowledge, as above, are the persons who are named, and described, as, and professing to be the party, grantors, in the within, and, aforesaid Indenture.

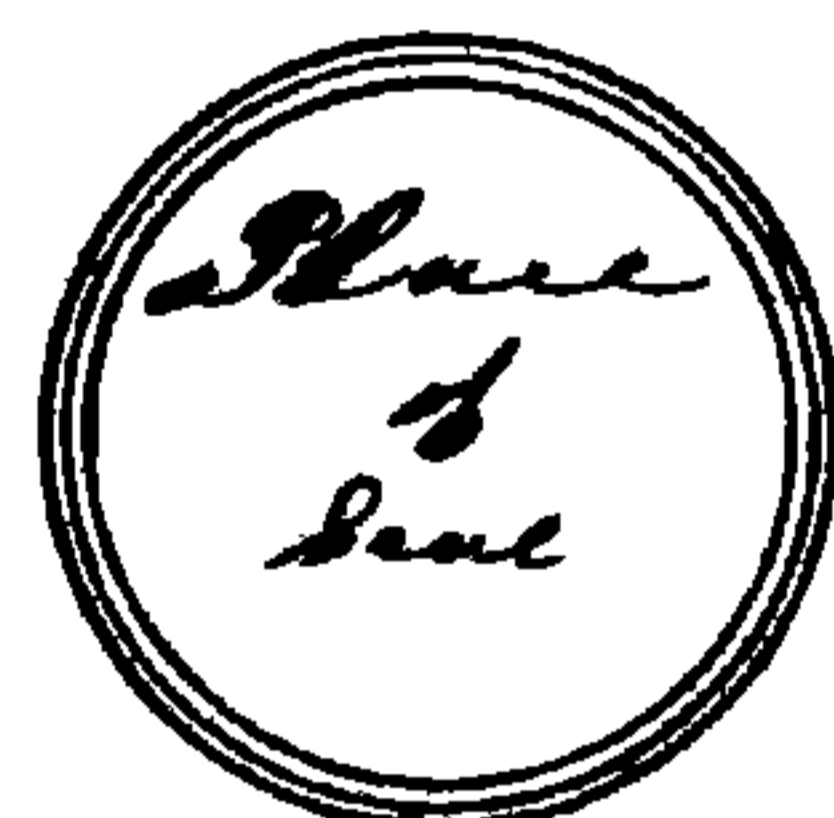

At the request of Nicholas Fogle the following Deed was Recorded January 14th 1856 Rec'd of 1 Stamp

This Indenture made this twelfth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred, and fifty five between William Sler and Mary his wife, Peter Sler and Susan his wife & Jeremiah Sler of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the first part and Nicholas Fogle of the State, and County aforesaid of the second part: Whereas the said William Sler by indenture of Mortgage bearing date on or about the twenty fourth day of February last, duly executed, and acknowledged, and recorded, among the Land Records of Frederick County Court, did for and in consideration of the sum of money, and premises therein mentioned, grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff & confirm unto the said Peter Sler and Jeremiah Sler, their heirs & assigns, all that part of a tract or parcel of Land, called "Sandy Spring" which belonged to said William Sler: Reference thereto being had will more fully appear, and whereas the said William Sler and Mary his wife have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell to the said Nicholas Fogle Seventeen acres & thirty six perches, of the aforesaid described parcel of Land, being the part thereof hereafter more particularly described, & furthermore the said Peter Sler, and Jeremiah Sler, do agree to join in the execution of this instrument of writing, as a full release, exoneration, acquittance and discharge, in, and to the aforesaid part or parcel of Land, as bargained and now sold, & now intended to be conveyed.

Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred, and fifty eight dollars and thirty seven and a half
