At the request of the Board of County School Commis-
sioners the following deed is recorded April 27, 1876.

This deed made this 28. day of December in the year Eighteen hundred
and sixty eight by us Nicholas Fogle, and Elizabeth Fogle his wife of Frederick Coun-
ty and State of Maryland, Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum
of Thirty Dollars, to the said Nicholas Fogle his wife do grant unto Keeper Thom-
as (President) George A. Pickinger, and others, members of the Board of School Com-
missioners of Frederick County aforesaid, and their successors, in said Capacity or
such officer who may hereafter have the control of the Public Schools of said County
all the following tract or parcel of Land lying in the County and State aforesaid, it
being part of a tract called "Sandy Spring". Beginning for the said part at the
end of the first line of a deed made by Conrad Her and Ann Maria Her to the
said Nicholas Fogle for Fifteen Acres & seven sq. of Land bearing date the 26.
day of June, 1843 and Recorded in Liber N. S. No. 21 folio 107 D, one of the Land
Records of Frederick County, and running thence with the second line of said conveyance
N 83° W. 9 1/4 ps then leaving the outlines of said conveyance South 29 1/2° East 11 ps.
to intersect the first line aforesaid, thence with it North 24° East 9 1/4 ps. to the Begin-
ning containing 41 square perches of Land more or less in fee simple.

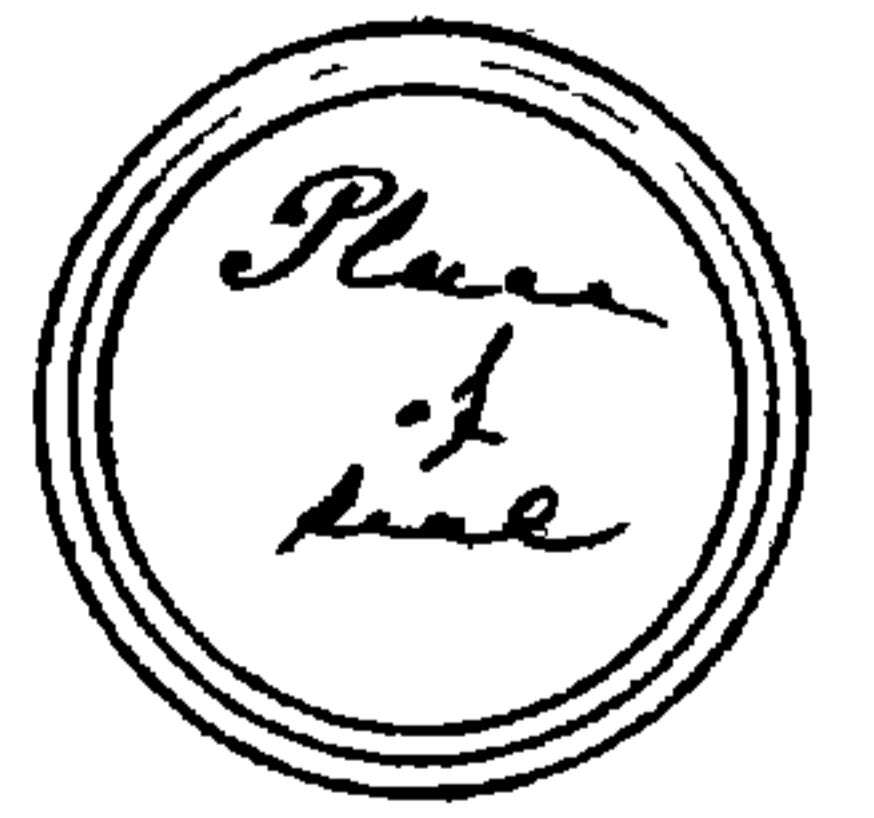
