Hundred, and seventy five, dollars to them in hand paid by him the said Nicholas Fogle, the said Jessa Geiselman and Elizabeth Geiselman his wife, doth hereby covenant unto the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in Woodlawn District, called Good Hill, it being the same that was conveyed from Peter Iler and Susannah Iler his wife to Christian Barrick, by deed bearing date the 13th day of June, 1859, and Recorded in Liber B. 9. 8. No. 4 folio 597 One of the Land Records of Frederick County Maryland, which by reference to said deed will more fully appear, the said tract of Land containing Ten and one half acres, in fee simple. The same having been conveyed by Nancy Barrick Administratrix of Christian Barrick dec'd to Jessa Geiselman by deed bearing date April 13th, 1867 (which through neglect had not been recorded) but the considerations involved having been satisfied by an Order of the Orphans Court for Frederick County on the 15th day of May 1865, that the said Nancy Barrick Administratrix of Christian Barrick dec'd, covenanted that she would warrant the property thereby conveyed, and that the said Jessa Geiselman, and Elizabeth Geiselman his wife doth hereby covenant that they will warrant, generally unto the said Nicholas Fogle his heirs and assigns forever, the property aforesaid.

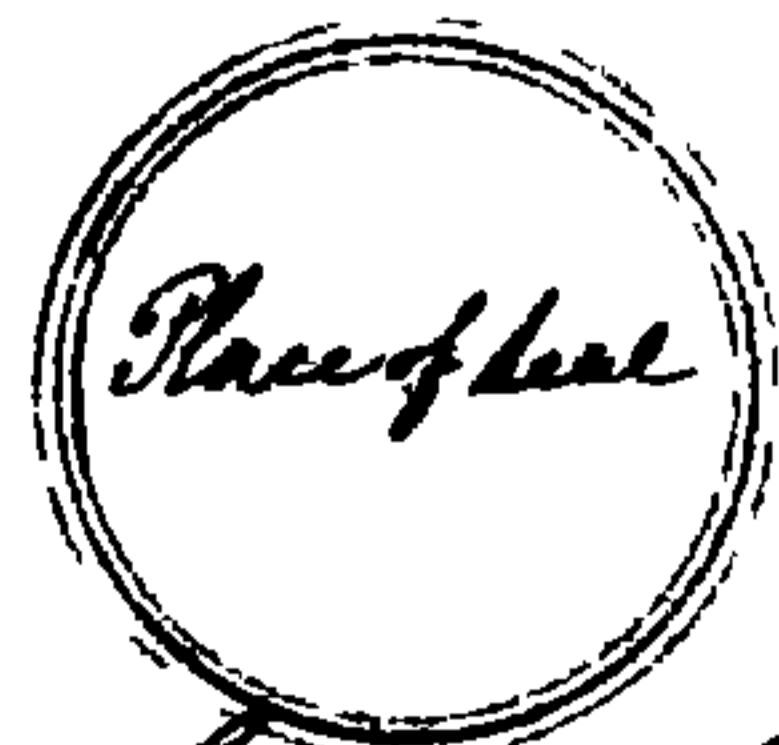
