 parcels into one entire survey, and with the outlines of said deed 3 lines, viz-
 N 83° W 35 1/2 ps to a stone - N 24° E 51 1/2 ps to a stone N. E 9° W 14 1/2 ps to a stone
 the Beginning of 10 1/2 Acres and 20 sq. ps. part of said Land, called "Sandy Spring"
 that was conveyed to the said Nicholas Fogle by the aforesaid Conrad Her and
 wife by deed bearing date the 6th day of April 1844 and Recorded in Liber
 H. S. No. 22, folio 593 D, one of the Land Records, aforesaid, then with the lines
 of said deed, reverted N 69° W 26 3/4 ps to a stone, S 13 1/2° W 32 3/4 ps. to a stone
 N. 87 1/2° W 18 1/2 ps to a stone, then S 10 1/2° E 37 ps to intersect the 6th line of the deed
 for the parcel aforesaid, containing 18 Acres and 7 sq. ps, then with said 6th line
 S 83° W 18 1/2 ps to a stone at the end thereof. It being also the end of the 3rd line in
 a deed from William Her and others to the said Nicholas Fogle for 17 Acres and
 36 ps of Land part of said tract of Land, called "Sandy Spring", bearing date
 the 12th day of November, 1855, and Recorded among the Land Records of Fred-
 erick County, aforesaid in Liber E. S. No. 7 folio 206 F and running thence
 with the 4th line of said deed S 78 1/2° W 88 3/4 ps to the Beginning stone of said deed
 then with the first and second lines thereof S 12° E. 28 7/10 ps to a stone N 81° E 89 1/2 ps to a
 stone near the stump of a Pear tree It being the end of the 3rd line of a parcel of Land, called
 "Long Bottom enlarged", and part of the tract called "Sandy Spring", containing 8 1/2 Acres
 and 11 sq. ps. of Land, that was conveyed to the said Nicholas Fogle by the aforesaid Con-
 rad Her and wife by deed bearing date the 28th day of May 1838, and Recorded among
 the Land Records aforesaid in Liber H. S. No. 7 folios 82 & 83, and running thence with
 the outline of said deed S 11° E. 14 ps. to a stone N 83° E 62 7/10 ps to a stone planted
 on the 22nd line of the tract called "Long Bottom Enlarged", then with a straight line
 N 24° E. 43 7/10 ps to the first mentioned place of Beginning containing 5 3/4 ps. Acres and
 16 1/2 sq. ps. of Land, more or less. Excluding thereout 41 sq. ps. of Land that was heretofore
 conveyed by the said Nicholas Fogle to the School Commissioners of Frederick County
 will leave the quantity of 53 Acres 2 rods and 15 1/2 sq. ps. of Land as hereby returned
