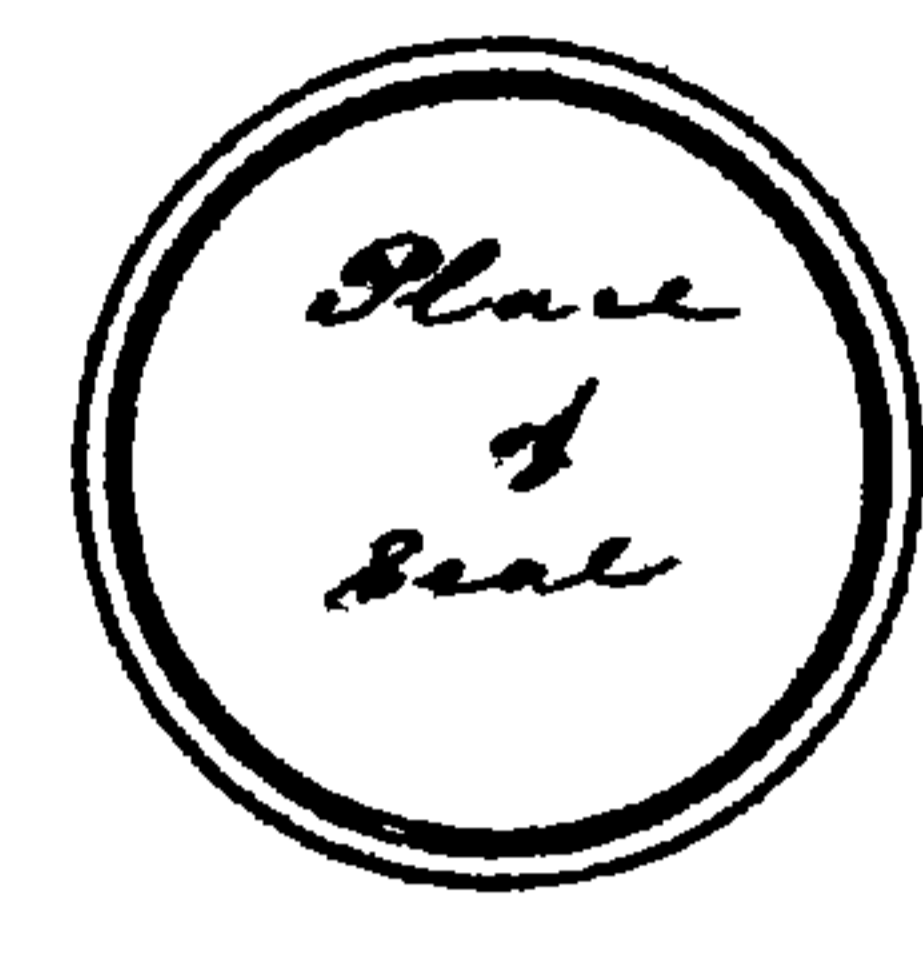

Petition of Michael Foyle

The Petition of Michael Foyle Trustee in No. 4430 Equity respectfully shows unto your Honor that on the 14th day of February 1880 he sold at Public Sale to Isaac Eyles a portion of the Land decreed to be sold by the decree passed in No. 4430 Equity on the terms and for the price as set forth in said Report of Sales.

That on the fifth day of April 1880, the said purchaser Isaac Eyles, filed his exceptions in your Honorable Court to said sale praying that said sale might be set aside because of the filing of a caveat by Lydia Ann Eyles and Daniel J. Eyles her husband, as will appear by reference to said Petition and was the only cause assigned why said sale should be set aside, and which affected the title of the Land sold by said Trustee to said Petitioner. Your Petitioner further states that no further or other proceedings have been taken in said Cause by the said Isaac Eyles the purchaser aforesaid, except that some testimony was taken before the Commissioner to support the allegations of the Petition aforesaid.

Your Petitioner further states that all disputes and disagreements over the Will of Nicholas Foyle late of said County, have now been settled and the caveat of said Lydia Ann Eyles and Daniel J. Eyles her husband filed in the Orphans Court of Frederick County against said will, has been dismissed, as will appear by a certified Copy of said Order herewith filed marked Exhibit A.

And your Petitioner further states that the only cause and objection to said sale having been removed, he prays that said sale may be finally ratified and confirmed.
