This deed made this 9th day of April in the year 1869 by us George W. Ezyler and Margaret C. Ezyler his wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty one Dollars and fifty cents, we the said George W. Ezyler and Margaret C. Ezyler do grant unto Eliza Ann Warfield, all the following tract or parcel of Land lying in Frederick County aforesaid, abeing part of a tract of Land called "The Return on Seven Originals," and part of a tract of Land called "Noah's Lot," Beginning for the same at a stone planted at the end of the line of the tract called "The Return on Seven Originals, and running thence N 39° E 12 1/2 ps. N 37° E 16 1/2 ps. then S 82 1/2° E 11 1/2 ps. to the Beginning, containing 1 Acre and 8 square perches of Land more or less in fee simple. And we the said George W. Ezyler and Margaret C. Ezyler his wife do covenant that we will warrant the property hereby conveyed.
