Interrogatories to be propounded to witnesses to be produced on the part of the Complainants in the above case.

- 1st. What is your name, age, and place of residence?
2. Do you know the parties to this suit, and if yea, how long have you known them?
3. Did you know Alexander Warfield, late of Frederick County? If yea, is he living or dead and if dead, when and where did he die?
4. Did said Alexander Warfield leave a widow, and if yea, what was her name? did she ever remarry and is she now living or dead? If dead, when and where did she die?
5. Did said Alexander Warfield die seized and possessed of any real estate, and if yea, describe the same, and state its quantity and value?
6. Look at Exhibits Nos 1 & 2, now shown you, and state whether or not the real estate therein described is that of which said Alexander Warfield died seized and possessed?
7. State whether or not the said Alexander Warfield, and Eliza A. Warfield were seized and possessed of any real estate, as joint tenants, at the time of the death of the said Alexander Warfield, and if yea, describe the same and state its quantity and value? Look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit No 4 & 5, and state whether or not the real estate therein described is that of which said Alexander & Eliza A. Warfield were seized and possessed as joint tenants?
8. State whether or not said Eliza A. Warfield, conveyed any portion of said Real estate described in Exhibits Nos 4 & 5, after the death of said Alexander Warfield and if you look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit No 7, and state whether or not the real estate therein described is that of which was so conveyed by said Eliza A. Warfield?
9. State whether or not said Eliza A. Warfield died seized and possessed of all the real estate described in Exhibits Nos 4 & 5, other than that conveyed by the deeds of which Exhibit 7 is a copy?
10. State whether or not said Eliza A. Warfield died seized and possessed of any other real estate than that heretofore described, and if yea, describe the same and state its quantity and value? Look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit No. 8 and state whether the real estate therein described is that of which said Eliza A. Warfield so died seized & possessed?
11. State whether or not there is any mortgage upon said real estate, or any portion of the same, and if yea, by whom and when was the same executed and for what amount, and by whom is the same held? State whether the same has ever been paid and if not state how much is now due on the same. Look at Exhibit No. 9, now shown you and state whether the same is a copy of such mortgage?
12. State whether or not said Alexander Warfield left any legal heirs, and if yea, give their names, ages and places of residence? State what relation they were to said Alexander Warfield, and if any of them are married, give the names of their husbands or wives, and if any have since died leaving heirs, give the names of such and the names, ages and places of residence of such heirs?
13. Did said Eliza A. Warfield leave any children or other heirs at law, and if yea give their names, ages and places of residence, and if any of them are married, give the names of their husbands or wives?
14. State where and how said real estate is situated with reference to being in one or more tracts?
