3. - Was or was not the said Nancy Evans, at the time of her death seized and possessed of Real Estate situated in Frederick County? If yes describe it. Look at papers now shown you marked Exhibit No. 11, and state whether or not said paper contains an accurate description of said real estate.
4. - Did or did not said Nancy Evans leave a husband surviving her? If yes, state his name, age, and present place of residence?
5. - Did or did not said Nancy Evans leave any children or descendants surviving her? If yes state their names, ages, conditions in life, and present places of residence.
6. - Was or was not said Nancy Evans indebted to any persons at the time of her death? If yes state fairly your knowledge known.
7. - Was or was not said Nancy Evans, at the time of her death seized and possessed of any personal estate?
8. - Did or did not said Nancy Evans leave a will?
9. - Who paid the funeral expenses of said Nancy Evans, and to what amount?
