This Indenture, made this Thirteenth day of March in the year 1847, between
 Ezra Slifer and Matilda Slifer his wife of said Ezra Slifer, of Frederick County and State
 of Maryland of the one part & John N. Garrott of the County & State aforesaid of the other part
 Witnesseth, that the said Ezra Slifer & Matilda Slifer, for and in consideration of the sum
 of Two thousand Dollars current money of Maryland to them in hand paid by the said John
 N. Garrott, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained & sold, al-
 iened, enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain & sell, alie, enfeoff & confirm
 to him the said John N. Garrott his heirs & assigns forever, all the following piece or parcel of Lands, situate,
 lying, and being in the County & State aforesaid, formerly part of the Real estate of Henry Riv-
 kett dec'd. - Beginning for the same at a stone in the middle of the Road near the North Corner of
 the Burying ground, in Bitternall and running thence N 25 1/2 W 28 5/10 ps to a stone S 64 W 6 1/10
 ps. to a stone N 20 W 1 1/10 ps to a stone N 21 W 1/10 of a perch to a stone N 47 W 18 ps to a stone N 53 1/2 E
 30 ps, N 56 E 4 ps to a stone then with Sethman Peters dec'd reversed N 65 W 16 1/2 ps N 16 1/2 E 46 1/2
 ps, N 71 E 88 ps to a stone formerly planted S 1 1/2 W 44 1/10 ps into the middle of the Public Road leading
 from Middletown to Bitternall, then in & along the middle of the said Road (By S 65 1/2 W 80 1/2 ps
