This deed, made this fifth day of April in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty seven by me Reuben Sheetshelm of Frederick County Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of Seventy five dollars received of Ezra Brandenburg of said County, I the said Reuben Sheetshelm do grant unto the said Ezra Brandenburg all the following described piece or parcel of Land lying and being in Mt. Pleasant District and being called part of "Middle Plantation", it being part of the same parcel of Land conveyed to the said Sheetshelm by E Louis Lowe Trustee by deed dated June 14th, 1860 and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County in Liber B. G. J. folio 649 D, reference thereto had well more fully appear. Beginning at a stone standing at the South West corner of the said Ezra Brandenburg's farm and running North seventy two degrees West three perches near the New Market and North seven degrees East ninety perches to a large White Oak thence East two and a half perches or until it intersects the South West line of the said Ezra Brandenburg's land; then with said line to the beginning Containing One and a half acres and seven square perches of Land more or less
