This deed, made this Eighteenth day of December in the year Eigh-
teen hundred, and sixty by Ezra Brandenburg and Margaret E. Branden-
burg his wife, Witnesseth, that in consideration of ten dollars the said Ezra Bran-
denburg and Margaret E. Brandenburg his wife, do grant unto William H. Lease,
all the following piece, or parcel of Land, called part of "Middle Plantation",
Beginning at the end twenty eight Perches on a line drawn N 71 1/2 West from Mt. Zion
Church, then with said line North seventy one, and a half degrees West thirty eight and
a half per. North eighty three degrees East twenty three perches South fifty one degrees East
six perches, then with a straight line to the beginning Containing two acres, two cords and
fifteen perches of Land, more or less, and the said Ezra Brandenburg, and wife, do further
grant unto Wm H. Lease the privilege of a Spring of water on the North East side of
the Public Road leading from Mt. Zion Church to Mount Hope School House, and
they further give the said Lease the full right to convey the said water in pipes to the
said Lease House under a penalty of One hundred dollars.
