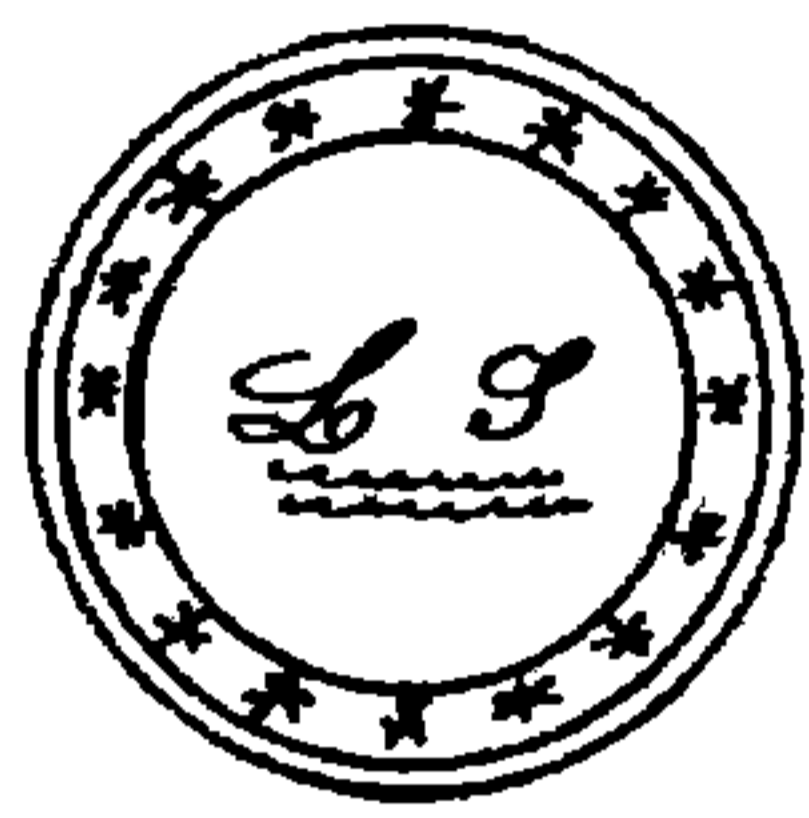

This Indenture, made this seventh day of May, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty six, between Henry Shook, and Susanna Rebecca Shook his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the One part; and Daniel Shook of the said County and State of the other part. Whereas Elizabeth Shoop, late of the County and State aforesaid, did by her last will and testament bearing date the 19th day of March Eighteen hundred and forty, among other things therein contained, did will and bequeath to Daniel Shook and Henry Shook of the County and State aforesaid, all her Real Estate, called "Shoop Conclusion," siting and lying in the County and State aforesaid. Whereas the said Daniel Shook and Henry Shook hold an undivided interest in said land, - And Whereas the said Daniel Shook being desirous to own and possess the said Land solely hereon and hereby to be described and conveyed, Now This Indenture Witnesseth, that the said Henry Shook and Susanna Rebecca Shook his wife, for the Consideration of the above premises, and the further sum of One hundred and sixty dollars, current money, by the said Daniel Shook to the said Henry Shook, in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge, the said Henry Shook and Susanna R. Shook his wife, have bargained and sold, aliened and conveyed, and by these presents, do give, grant, bargain and sell, alien convey release and confirm unto the said Daniel Shook his heirs and assigns, all that piece or part of a tract or parcel of Land herein before referred to, and named, and contained within the following metes and bounds courses and distances to wit. Beginning for the same (it being the Lot No. 1, on the plat dated March 1854), at the end of 58 perches on the 17th line of the whole tract called "Shoop's Conclusion," and running thence with it North 17 degs West 3 1/4 perches to a stake drove in the ground, then leaving said original line, and running by and with Proutaker's line for five acres of Land, part of "Shoop's Conclusion," North 6 3/4 degs West 57 1/4 perches, then leaving said line, and running South, 5 7/8 degs West 19 fms. to the end of the 5th line for part of "Shoop's Conclusion," conveyed by Elizabeth Shoop to Daniel R. Shook for 13 Acres 1 Rod and 5 perches of Land, by deed bearing date the 5th day of
