This deed made this Tenth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six, by Jacob Gittle of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of Twenty dollar the said Jacob Gittle doth grant unto Samuel Kolue of the County and State aforesaid, all that lot of ground situated in the County of Frederick, which is described as follows, being part of an original tract of Land called "The Recovery on Andrew Platter": Beginning for the same, at a stone standing in the Public Road leading to the Frederick Pike and running thence South 42° East 6 1/2 feet to intersect a line of the said Jacob Gittle's deed of George Rowles for 15 1/2 Acres, and running thence with said line North 72° West, 12 1/4 feet to the aforesaid Public Road, then with said road North 85° East, 9 1/2 feet to the beginning, Containing twenty six square perches of Land, more or less, in fee simple.

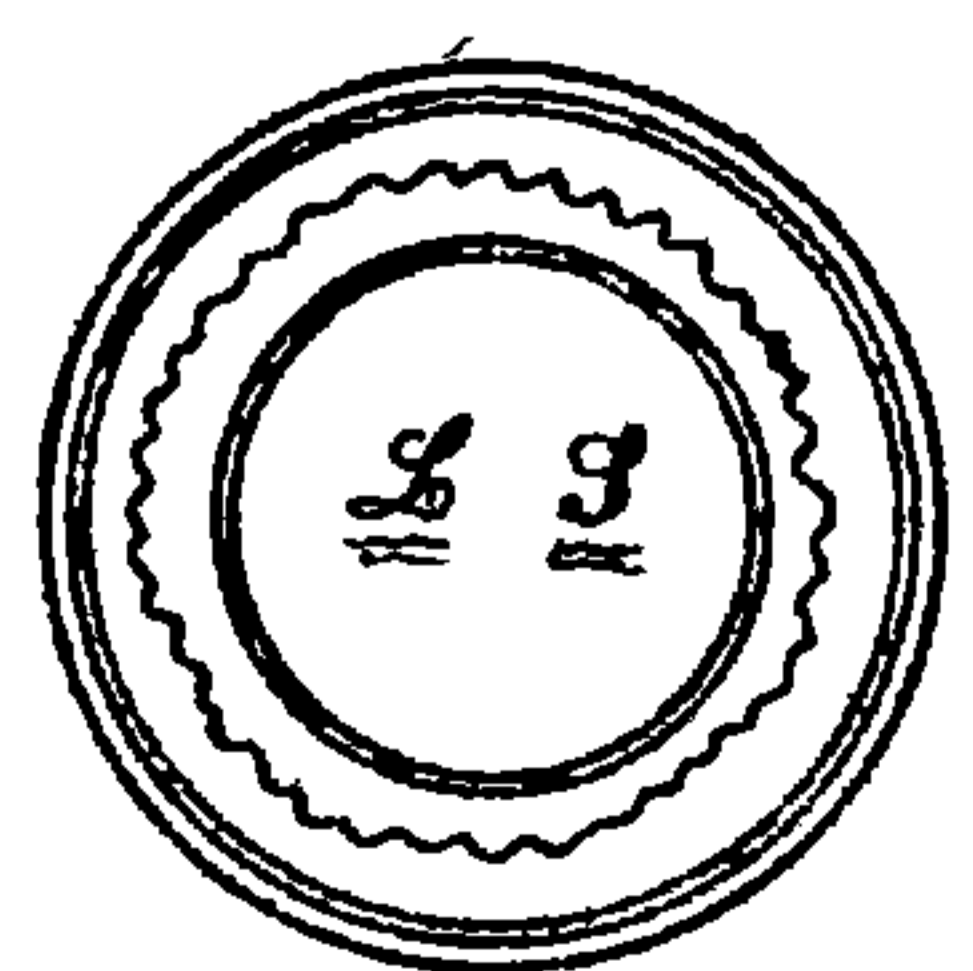
