

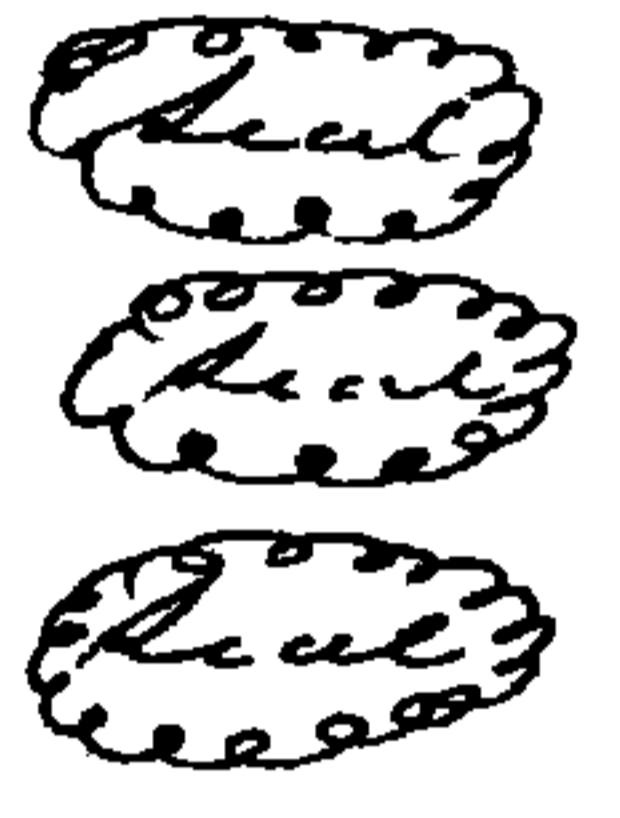

Gettle & wife to George Muck and Annie Slifer; thence with said line S 12° E 6 1/2 perches, to the beginning, containing sixty five perches of Land, excepting the privilege of a road thirty feet wide across the West end of said Lot, along the last line thereof. The said George Muck and Joshua Slifer and his wife Annie Slifer do also grant unto the said Daniel Kline the right and privilege to pass & repass to and from a certain spring a short distance North-East from said Lot, and to use the water of said spring for family purposes; also the right and privilege to erect a spring house at or near said spring, also the privilege to pass and repass to and from the small branch or creek immediately North of the Lot hereby conveyed.

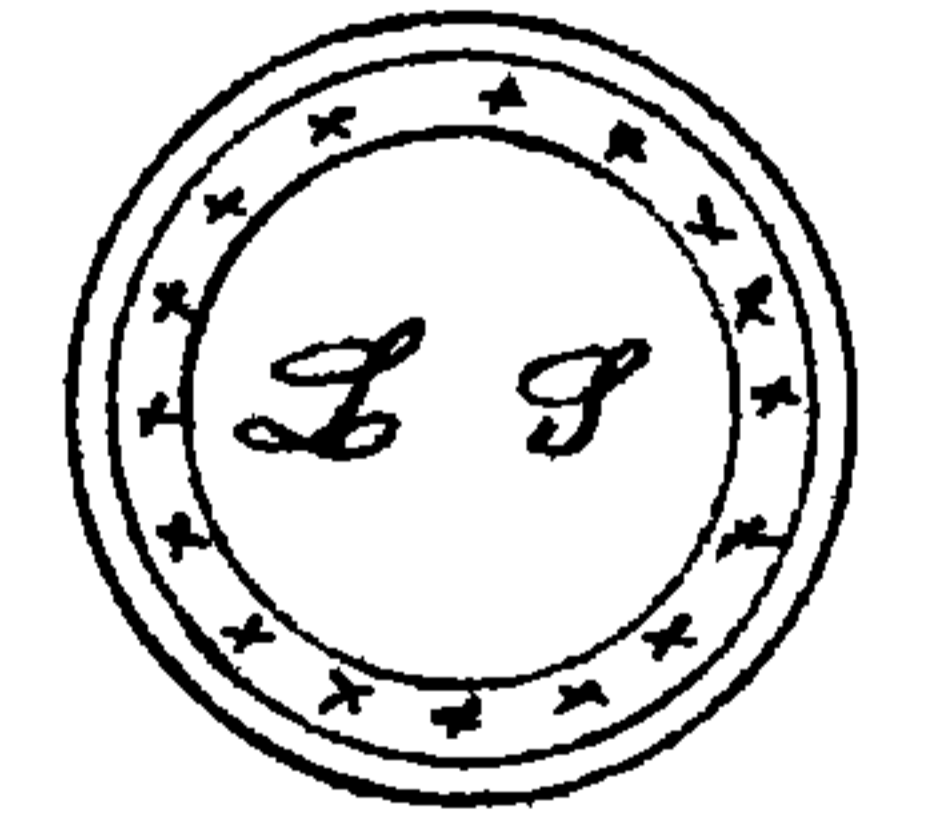
