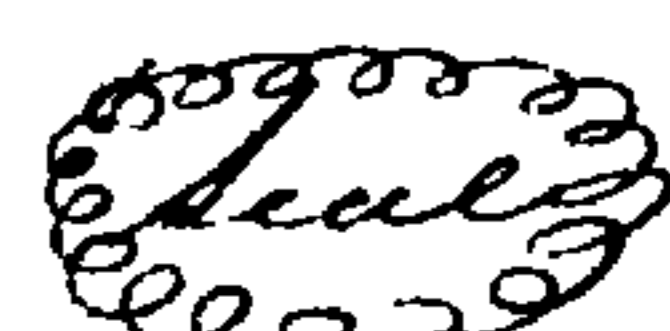
This deed, made this Eighth day of June, in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty eight, by me John Simmons Trustee, Witnessed, whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity in No. 3370, passed on the 20th day of April last in the case of S. C. Simmons versus Charles H. Marriott & the said John Simmons was appointed to sell the Land decreed to be sold, and have sold the same to Alpheus W. Marriott for Seven hundred dollars, who has fully paid the purchase money therefor. Now therefore, in consideration of the premises, I, the said John Simmons Trustee, do grant unto Alpheus W. Marriott all the right and title of the party to the aforesaid cause, amount to One fourth part of that piece or parcel of Land, situate, lying and being in Frederick County and called and known as part of "Hammond's Request," being a portion of the land which was allotted to Adelin Marriott by certain Commissioners appointed to divide the Real Estate of Charles Hammond deceased which Report and Minutes of said Commissioners is recorded in Liber No. 1 folio 348 &c, one of the Record Books of "Direct Descents" in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as by reference thereto being had, will more fully, and at large, appear.

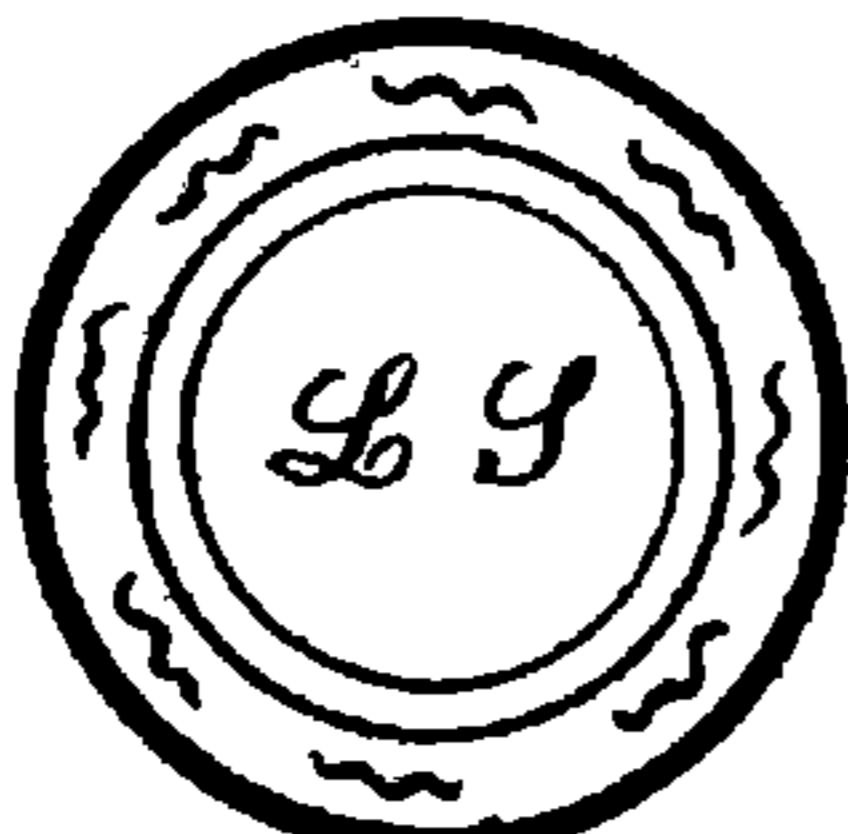
