The Petition and Report of Lloyd H. Hyatt, and Thomas H. Williard Trustees of Elizabeth Trunk respectfully represents, that a certain Elizabeth Trunk made and executed to your petitioners a certain deed of Trust, which deed of Trust was duly recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County and a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part of this petition marked Exhibit No. 1, and your Petitioners refer to said Exhibit for a full statement of the details of said Trust.

Your Petitioners further state that the funds received by them to be distributed under the deed of Trust are Eight hundred and thirty-two dollars, and ninety cents, that there is due to Catholic Lodge of Odd Fellows upon the judgment referred to in said deed of Trust One hundred and twenty-two dollars, that the balance due from the Trust funds in this case upon the Mortgage of your petitioner Lloyd H. Hyatt, is One hundred and ninety dollars and sixty-eight cents, that the sum which Thomas H. Williard has agreed to accept in satisfaction of his Mortgage is Three hundred and Eighty-one dollars, and seventy cents, though the sum due him is in fact something larger.
