Complainant

W. A. Shauk of Baltimore County in the State of Maryland, humbly complaining, respectfully shew unto your Honorable Court, that heretofore, to wit on or about the day of September A. D. 1876, a certain Catharine Faithful departed this life intestate, in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, seized and possessed of about eighty acres of Land, of the value of, about One thousand Dollars, which is situate, in Frederick County, in said State, and is, correctly described in the paper writing herewith filed, marked Exhibit "A", which together with all other exhibits herewith filed, your Complainants pray may be taken and considered as part of this Bill of Complaint. Further shew that the said intestate, at the time of her death, left Henry Faithful her husband surviving her, and the following Grand children her only heirs at Law, to wit Your Complainants Emma J. Buckingham, wife Alfred J. Buckingham and William A. Shauk, and Morjia L. Shauk, Garrett R. Shauk, and Frank B. Shauk, all of whom reside in Carroll County, Maryland, except the said William A. Shauk who resides in Baltimore County, in the State of Maryland, the said Emma J. and Alfred J. Buckingham, and William A. Shauk, being adults, above the age of Twenty one years, and the rest being infants under the age of twenty one years.

Further shew unto your Honor that the said Henry Faithful, departed this life in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, aforesaid in the month of April A. D. 1880.

Further shew unto your Honor that the said Emma J. Buckingham, William A. Shauk, Morjia L. Shauk, Garrett R. Shauk and Frank B. Shauk are the only children, and heirs at Law of Emily C. Shauk, who was the only child and heir at Law of the said Catharine, and who died, in the month A. D. 1862 intestate in Carroll County, in said State previous to the death of the said intestate, Catharine, leaving the aforesaid children, and Garrett M. Shauk her husband surviving her who resides in Carroll County, aforesaid, and your Complainants further shew unto your Honorable Court that said Real estate, at the death of the said Catharine Faithful descended to, and vested in, your Complainants, and the other children of the said Emily C. and Garrett M. Shauk, as the only heirs at Law of the said intestate, Catharine.

Further shew that the aforesaid Real estate herewith before mentioned and described in said Exhibit "A", is not susceptible of advantageous division among the parties entitled thereto, and that the same, cannot be divided without loss or injury to the parties interested.

To the end therefore that the said Garrett M. Shauk, surviving husband of Emily C. Shauk deceased, Morjia L. Shauk, Garrett R. Shauk, and Frank B. Shauk may answer the several matters and things herein before stated, as fully and particularly as if they were herein again repeated, and they were thereunto specially interrogated, and that the said Real estate may be by a decree of your Honorable Court, decreed to be sold, and the proceeds divided among the parties entitled thereto. May it please your Honor to pass a decree for the sale of the same, and also grant unto your Complainants such other and further relief, as they may be in Equity entitled to, and also grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena of the State of Maryland, against the said Garrett M. Shauk surviving husband of Emily C. Shauk deceased, Morjia L. Shauk, Garrett R. Shauk, and Frank B. Shauk, all of Carroll County in the State of Maryland, commanding them to be, and appear in this your Honorable Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises, abide by, stand
