2d Int. - I did know Catharine Faithful, during her lifetime She is dead - she died in Frederick County, Maryland, about four years ago.

3d Int. - She died intestate

4th Int. - Waived, as to this deponent.

5th Int. - She died leaving a husband named Henry Faithful, surviving her The said Henry Faithful died sometime during last winter, in Frederick County, Maryland.

6th Int. - She left no child, at the time of her death, but she did leave Grand Children, who are the children of Emily C. Shauck, who was a daughter, and an only child of the said intestate, and who was the wife of Jarrett St. Shauck. She, the said Emily C. Shauck, died in Carroll County, Maryland, several years prior to the death of Catharine Faithful, the intestate, leaving, at her death, and who are now living, Jarrett St. Shauck, her husband, surviving her, and the following named children, to wit: Emma S., now the wife of Alfred S.
