Your Petitioner therefore prays your Honor to pass an order to be served upon all the parties to said Equity who are, all the heirs of said Catharine Faithful, as well, as upon the Trustee to show cause if any they have by some certain day to be named, in the Order why said Acre of Land, as described by Cause and distance in Exhibit No 2 to the petition should not be excepted from said sale by said Trustee and right to use of water, reserved to your Petitioner her heirs and assigns, and why said Trustee or some Trustee to be appointed for the purpose should not convey said Acre of Land, and water right to your Petitioner and as in duty bound &c

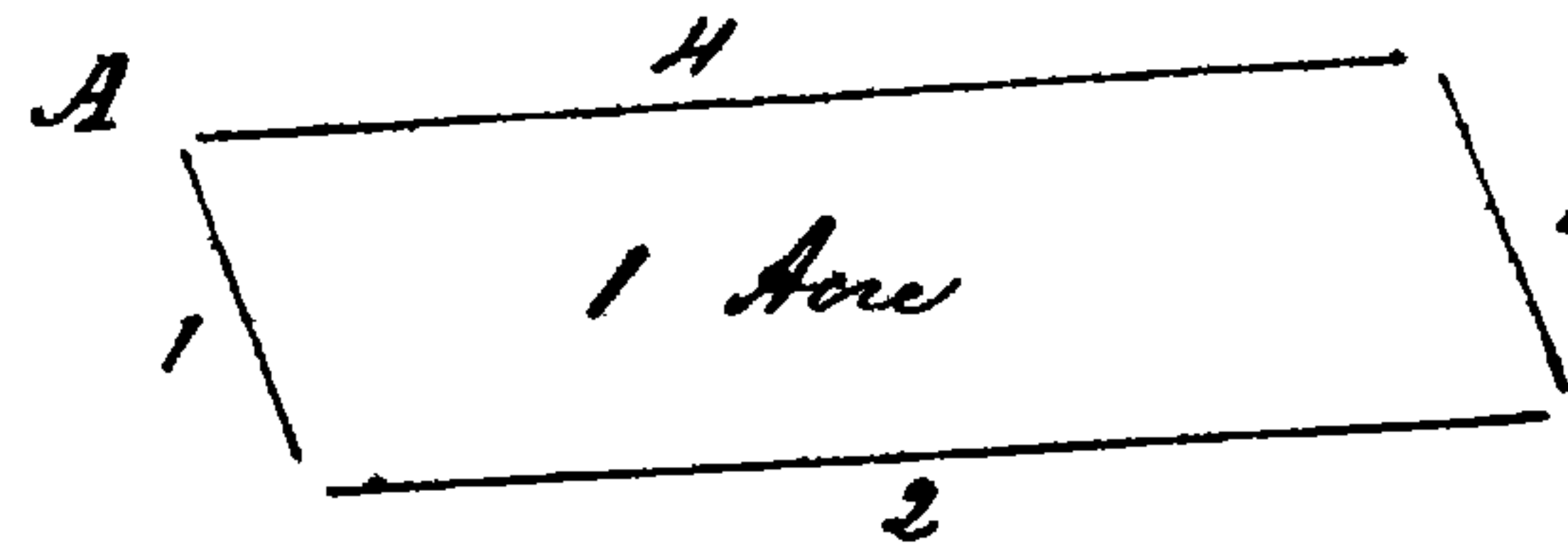
