further states that he is the administrator of the Lands and Chattels of Lewis A. Brengle, late of Frederick County, deceased, that he hath fully administered said estate in the Orphans Court for Frederick County, that at the time of the death of said Lewis A. Brengle, he the said Lewis A. Brengle had in his hands One thousand Dollars, which he claimed to hold, as Trustee of Matilda Shafer the Petitioner in this Cause, and as Trustee of Ann R. Gittinger of Baltimore City, State of Maryland, in equal proportions. That of said sum of One thousand dollars, six hundred, and ten dollars (\$1610.) is now invested in the Weekly Deposits of the Frederick Town Savings Institution, and stands there on the Books of said Frederick Town Savings Institution in the name of Lewis A. Brengle Trustee, and has so stood in the name of Lewis A. Brengle Trustee ever since the 17th day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty seven.

That the said Lewis A. Brengle paid to the said Matilda Shafer, and to the said Ann R. Gittinger the interest on the said six hundred and ten dollars in equal proportions from the time he first held the same as trustee until the time of the death of the said Lewis A. Brengle which occurred in November, 1879

He Alexander Brengle further states that the remaining three hundred and ninety Dollars (\$390) was been invested by him in the weekly Deposits of the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick City, State of Maryland, and the said Weekly Deposits were bought by him at Public Sale on the 20th day of March in the year 1880, at a premium of One Dollar, and fifty cents on every one hundred Dollars stock par value he has bought costing him Three hundred and ninety five dollars, and eighty five cents, the said Alexander Brengle intending to reimburse himself from the interest he shall receive from said stock for the premium he has paid thereon

The said Alexander Brengle further states that the Frederick Town Savings Institution, is now paying six per cent interest annually on its Weekly Deposits, free from taxes, and the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick City, your Trustee Alexander Brengle says, is now paying six per cent annually on the three hundred and ninety dollars Weekly Deposits he holds in it, as Trustee, subject to Taxes, and he believes both said investments are as safe and profitable investments as he can find.

And the said Alexander Brengle states that he intends to pay to the said Matilda Shafer, and to the said Ann R. Gittinger during their respective lives, the interest on the said One thousand Dollars, invested as aforesaid, in the Frederick Town Savings Institution, and in the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick, in equal proportions, thus paying to each of them the interest on Five hundred Dollars annually during the life of each of them, according to the last will and testament of George S. Brengle late of Frederick County, deceased, as appears more fully by reference to Exhibits Nos 1 Filed with the respective petitions of the said Matilda Shafer and the said Ann R. Gittinger in No Equity in this Court, and in No Equity in this Court.

Your Petitioner Alexander Brengle prays your Honorable Court to ratify and confirm the investments he has made of the said Trust fund he holds for the benefit of Matilda Shafer aforesaid. All of which is respectfully submitted.
