D. 1878, to wit: "And I hereby ratify and confirm this, as a Codicil to my last will and Testament, aforesaid, bearing date, as aforesaid, on the nineteenth day of November, in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy; and also ratifying and confirming every part and clause of my aforesaid last will, so far as the same is not inconsistent with this my codicil thereto."
