This Mortgage, made this twelfth day of April, in the year Eighteen Hundred and seventy nine, by William Black and Barbara his wife, of Frederick County State of Maryland, Witnesseth that whereas Joseph H. Black, and the said William Black, by their promissory note, duly executed and bearing date of these presents stand indebted to Matthias P. Zacharias in the sum of Five hundred and sixty dollars, with interest thereon from the date hereof according to the tenor of their promissory note, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, we the said William Black, and Barbara his wife, do grant unto the said Matthias P. Zacharias, all that former tract of Land lying and situated in Frederick County, along the Ridge Road, and adjoining the lands of George R. Orelman and Christian J. Zacharias, and others, it being the same land that was conveyed to William Black by Joseph Martin and Henrietta his wife, by deed bearing date March twenty fourth, Eighteen hundred
