The Bell of Complaint of Christian Lantz of Frederick County, respectfully shows unto your Honors that some time about the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty seven, your Complainant being seized, and possessed of a tract of Mountain Land, described in a deed to him from the Executors of Isaac Baughen dec'd, a copy of which is herewith filed, as part of this Bell marked Exhibit No. 1, sold a portion of said Land, which is situated in Frederick County, & being about One hundred, and twenty three Acres, to one John A. Miller and gave said Miller possession of the same but did not execute a deed to said Miller for said Land because the purchase money was not fully paid and some time about the year Eighteen hundred, and seventy one, your Complainant being seized & possessed of another tract of land situated in said County, sold twenty three Acres, more or less of the same to said John A. Miller & said Miller, also took possession of said twenty three acres which are part of a tract of land, described in a deed from Jno. R. Harrigan to your Complainant, a copy of which is filed herewith, marked Exhibit No. 2; that said John A. Miller made sundry payments to your Complainant on account of said tracts of Land sold him as aforesaid but did not pay for either in full, and on the first day of April in the year eighteen hundred, and seventy eight there was a balance due your Complainant in account of both of said tracts of Land sold, as aforesaid of Three hundred and seven & 1/2 Dollars, and the said John A. Miller on said 1st day
